Hull City Council	Consultants appointed May 2009, completion expected November 2009.	An IDP will form part of the LDF and will be largely derived from the above work.
East Riding of Yorkshire Council	We are about to commission consultants to help us prepare an infrastructure study. Study will be partly done by consultants and partly by the Council. Estimated start date October 2009.	Yes, Have extracted schemes from the Capital Investment Programme, Geographic Programme and other plans (such as LTP, Flood Risk Management strategies). The number of schemes has reached over 120.
Harrogate Borough Council	Have done a fair amount of work on infrastructure to support the Core Strategy, but not as a separate. Will have to undertake much more work as part of Site Allocations over the next 12 months.	Will be preparing an IDP to support Allocations/Policies DPD over next 12 months.
Scarborough Borough Council	Not yet, have sent out briefs to consultants to get idea of costs for undertaking an Infrastructure Study. Start date depends on finding money required, but it is hoped that a consultant can be appointed in Summer/Autumn 2009.	Still to be decided.
Craven District Council	Infrastructure Audit currently underway. Timescale – Planning to present the final draft to Members in Dec 2009	This is more likely to be done along with Site Allocations DPD – Issues and Options in 2010.

Will be part of (or supporting document to) the Core Strategy – to be submitted in 2010.
North Yorkshire Moors NP	No, there are no locations for growth identified in CS. Will be looking at infrastructure issues in more detail as part of specific area DPDs.	Will be looking at as part of Whitby Business Park AAP and Helmsly DPD – both documents will be allocating sites.
North Yorkshire County Council	Studies to be undertaken as part of the Minerals and Waste Core Strategies. Timetable still under discussion following withdrawal of Waste Core Strategy.	As above.
Ryedale District Council	Have started work on looking at infrastructure needs.	This will be part of the Facilitating Development DPD.
Richmondshire District Council	Picking this work up as part of the Core Strategy, which it is anticipated will be submitted in approximately 12 months.	Again, this work will sit alongside the development of the Core Strategy.
